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BACKGROUND:

The Education Department proposes to discontinue the Curriculum and Instruction emphasis from the Special Education subplan of the MA Education program.

The rational for this deletion is to streamline the program and make it less confusing for students. Since the emphasis choice is not articulated anywhere on transcripts or diplomas, faculty have decided that it is an unnecessary part of the special education subplan. All courses will remain, no courses will be deleted, so students may still select a focus on curriculum and instruction elective graduate courses when planning their MA contract, if interested.
