- Highlights / Key takeaways:
 - Overall Budget:
 - \$84M base budget.
 - \$74M from student fees (most are restricted). \$10M from state (usually designated)
 - SA Division has growing needs, faces possible budget reductions when reductions in enrollment hit next year. Most carryover funds have been used to meet existing needs arising from pandemic and other economic difficulties our students face.
 - More students in need of basic needs services.
 - More students in need of counseling and mental health services.
 - Continuing need for health services.
 - o New Bronco Care Center opening in January 2023.
 - One-stop help center for students. Help available in person and online.
 - Case managers will help direct students to basic needs, financial aid, housing resources, CAPS if necessary.
 - Student Success Fees in SA:
 - Advising
 - Instructional Technology
 - Bronco Athletics
 - Identity and Cultural Centers
 - Rose Float
