Financial Aid Offers Sent to Admitted Students

- Provisional Financial Aid Offers sent **April 18th** to Fall 2024 admitted undergraduates
- Initial aid offers are "**Provisional**" as FAFSA corrections are anticipated within the next few weeks. Official offers will go out starting in late May.
- **20,677** undergraduates packaged, which is approximately 2,000 fewer than at this time last year.
