FAFSA Simplification

FAFSA Simplification will be the most significant change to financial aid in over 40 years, starting with the upcoming 2024–2025 aid year.

- The redesigned FAFSA is expected to launch in December 2023 for the 2024-25 academic year — a delay from the typical Oct. 1 release date.
- The 2024-25 Priority Filing deadline will be extended one month to April 2, 2024.
- The changes will impact everything related to financial aid.

Enrollment Management & Services

FAFSA Simplification – Few Key Changes

Expected Family Contribution (EFC) will become the Student Aid Index (SAI)

Everyone is required to create an FSA ID to access and submit the FAFSA

Everyone whose data is on FAFSA must consent to their information being transferred from the IRS, including non-tax-filers. No consent = Not eligible for aid.

Household size based on people listed on Tax Return

Students can no longer enter income information for parents

It will rely almost exclusively on information from a family's recent tax return (still prior year)

Less aid for multiple children in college

Increases aid for single parents

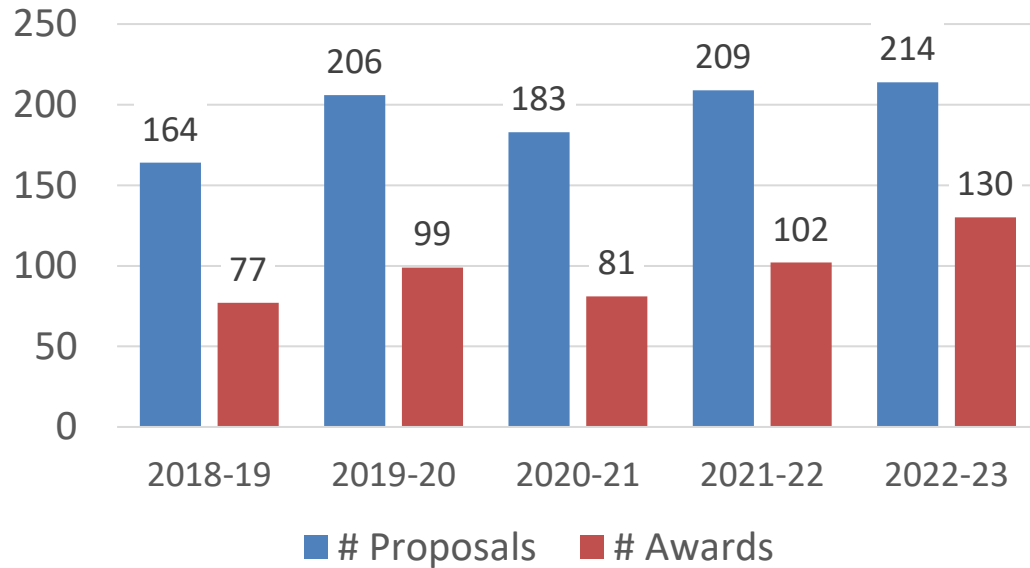
