Enrollment Management & Services

Fall 2023 Enrollment (Census)

- For Fall 2023, we achieved 98.6% of our campus enrollment headcount and 98.8% of our FTES enrollment goals.
- For Fall 2023, we welcomed 4,312 First-Time Freshmen and 2,864 Transfers as new Broncos.
- The Average Unit Load increased from 12.81 to 12.87, and the undergraduate AUL increased from 13.22 to 13.32.

Spring 2024 Enrollment Target

Our goal is FTES 6.6% above the CSU resident FTES funded target.

That is 21,433 CSU resident FTES.

We came in slightly below Fall 2023 goal.

Shortfall will be made up in Spring 2024.

We estimate we need approximately 437 spring transfer students to enroll.
