Review of Policy 1303 Appointment of Volunteer Faculty and Support Staff

Background

This referral is requesting a review of Policy 1303. According to the policy, the appointment of volunteer faculty and support staff are individuals who perform work or provide services without compensation whether on an on-going basis or for a short-term event. Volunteers are appointed by use of Volunteer Identification Form which must be kept on file in the appointing department for approximately one year.

Policy 1303 previously existed on the University Manual (UM 301.23). The policy is currently visible on the Academic Manual. There is no record of Policy 1303 being adopted by the Academic Senate or approved by the President. This referral is requesting a review of Policy 1303 to determine the policy's validity and relevancy of public listing on the Academic Manual. No prior Academic Senate report is available for review.

Additionally, the referral requests discussion on deconsolidating the appointment of volunteer faculty and support staff within the same policy. If determined by the Faculty Affairs Committee to deconsolidate the policy, then another referral should be generated to request individual policies for the appointment of volunteer faculty and support staff.
