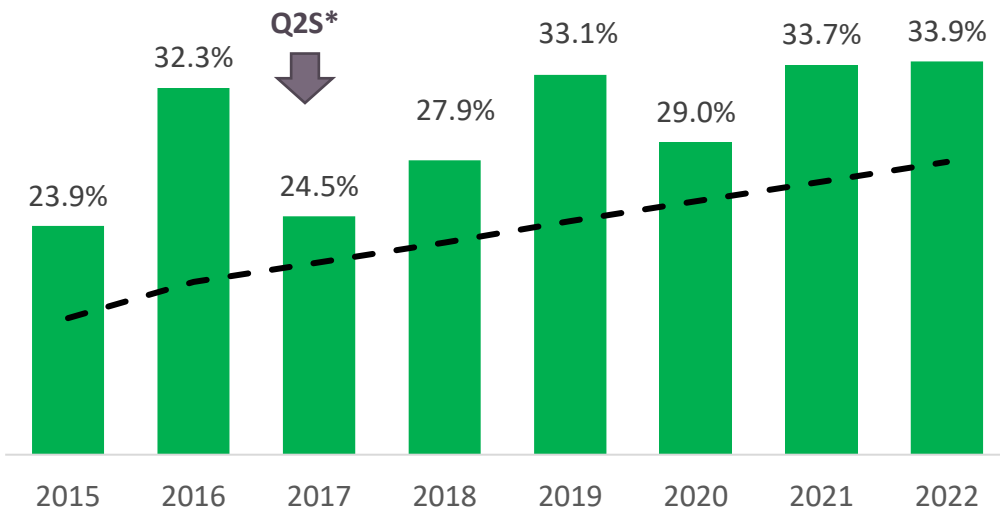

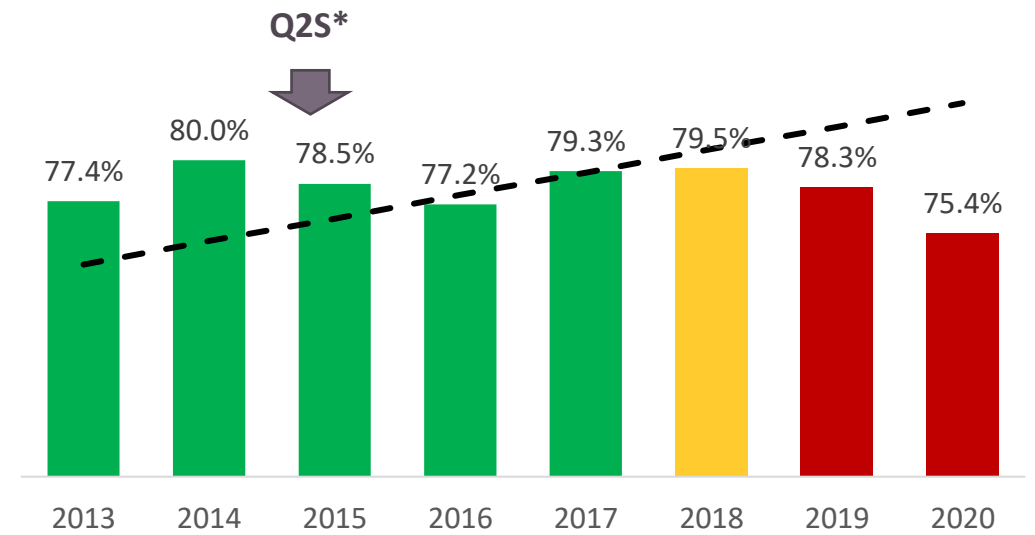
# Transfer Trends & Projections

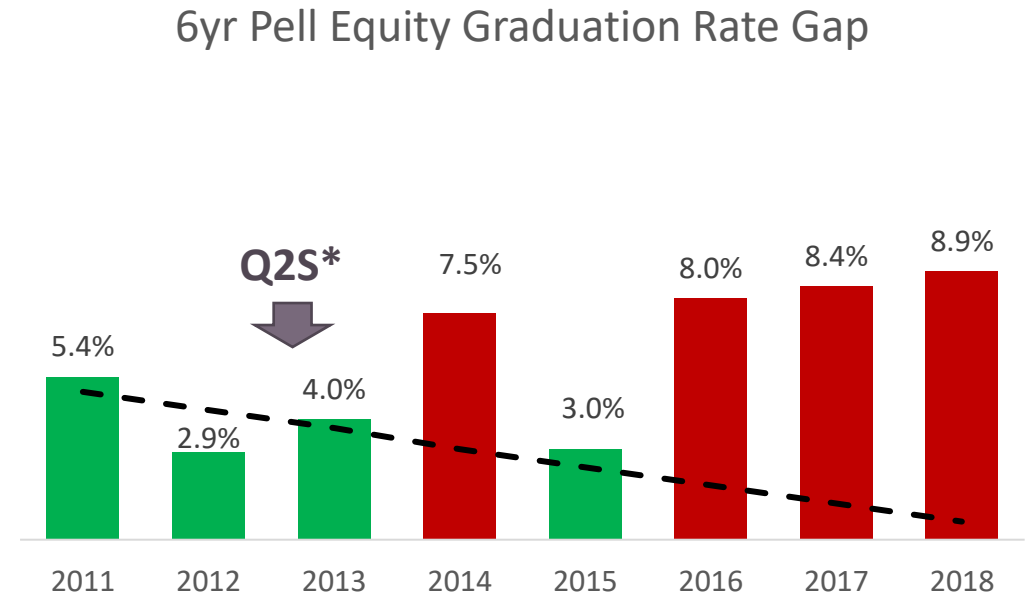
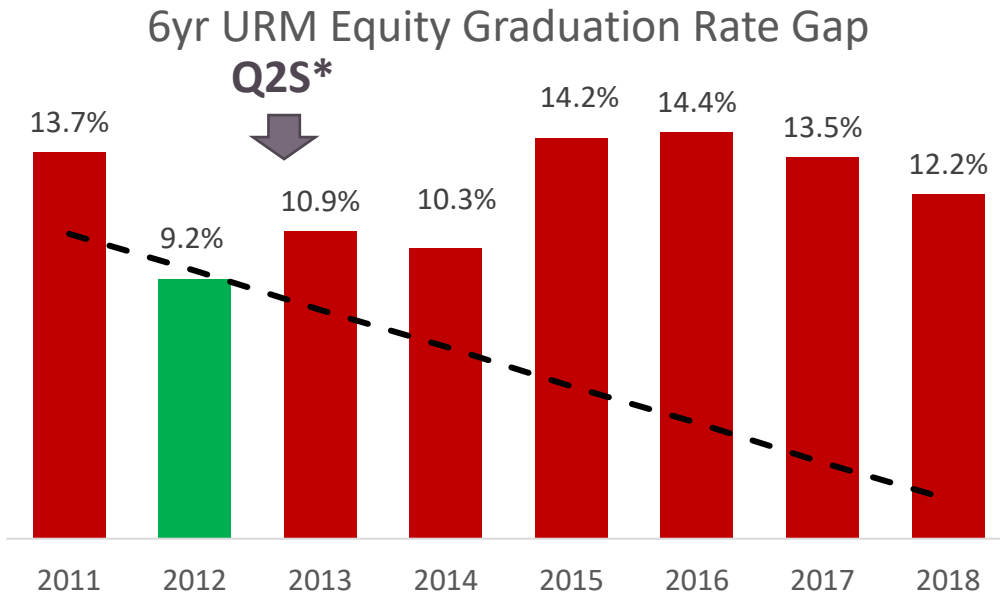
