

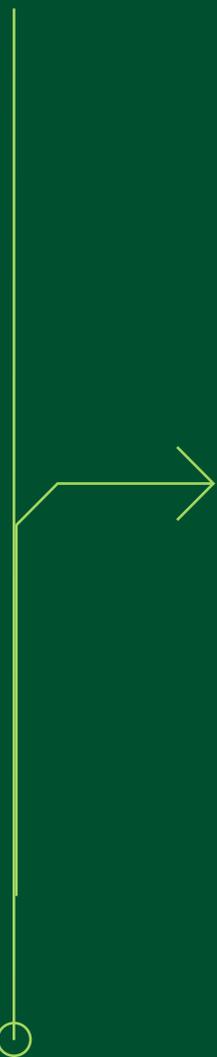

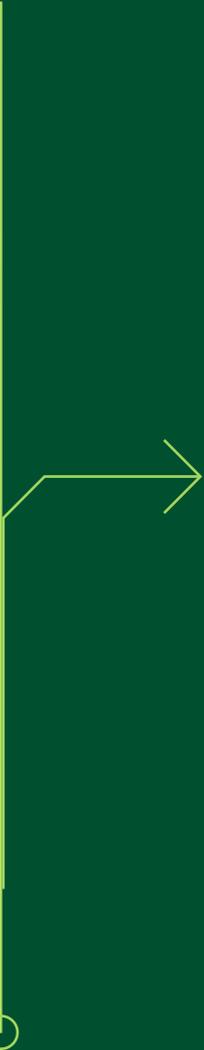

# Federal Financial Aid Changes (Effective July 1, 2026)

## Implications for Students and Enrollment

Policy Area	Key Change	Student Impact
<b>Pell Grant Eligibility</b>	Students whose non-federal aid fully covers their Cost of Attendance will no longer qualify for Pell Grants, even if otherwise eligible.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Some low-income students may lose Pell eligibility.</li><li>• Loss of eligibility could happen mid-late year, creating balance for funds received.</li></ul>
<b>Federal Loan Eligibility</b>	Less-than-full-time students will receive prorated federal loan eligibility based on enrollment level.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students enrolled less than full-time will have reduced access to federal loans.</li><li>• Could result in shortage of resources for covering institutional/education expenses.</li></ul>

- \$1500 stipend for completion of the program

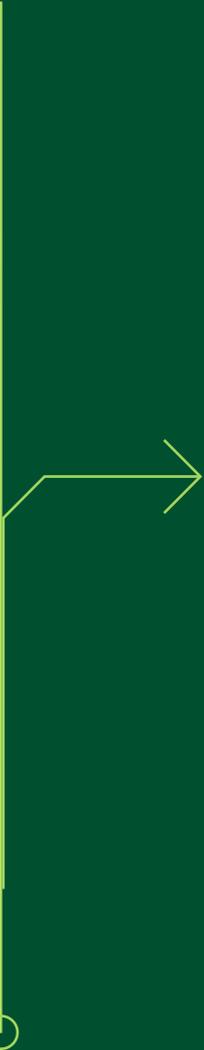

- The Committee awarded 17 faculty for 2026-2027



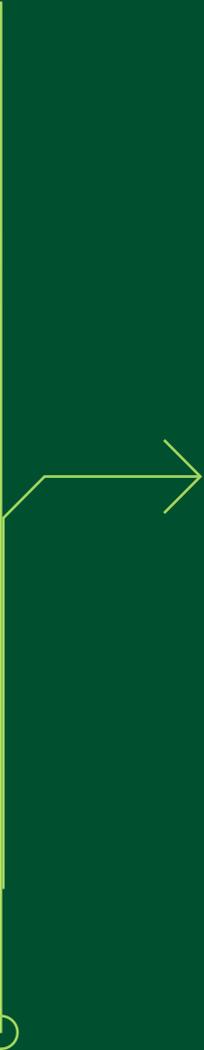

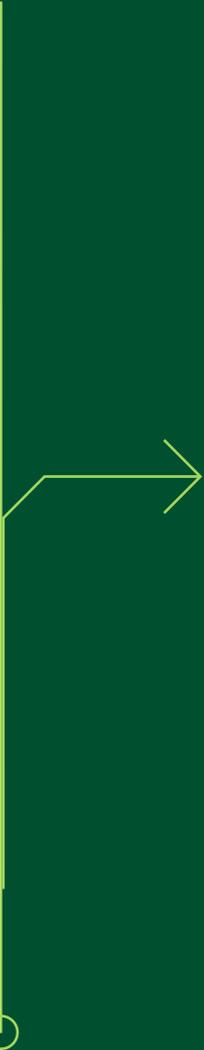
