Spring 2026 Enrollment Update

- Working to assure that we meet the overall 2025–26 enrollment goal
- Final day of General Registration; new student registration later this month
- Meeting the annual goal secures \$1.8M in permanent CSU funding

New Student Enrollment

- Spring 2026 new student target set higher to offset Fall 2025 shortfall in new students
- Larger spring class also helps address current continuing-student shortfalls

Spring 2026 Transfers

• Projected **1,163 new transfers** — largest spring transfer class in campus history

Overall Outlook


- Total enrollment projected to finish within 1% of the CY 2025–26 goal
- Slightly above the threshold needed to fully meet the annual target
