ACADEMIC SENATE RESOLUTION FOR THE BRONCO MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM

- WHEREAS, The California State Polytechnic University, Pomona (hereafter Cal Poly Pomona) Bronco men's basketball team distinguished itself at the pinnacle level, capturing its first National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division II National Championship before a national television audience on CBS-TV; and
- WHEREAS, Head coach and faculty member Greg Kamansky was named National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) National Coach of the Year, Division II Bulletin Coach of the Year, Basketball Times Coach of the Year, California Collegiate Athletic Association Coach of the Year, NABC West Region Co-Coach of the Year; and
- WHEREAS, College of Business Administration major and student athlete Austin Swift was named NCAA Elite Eight Most Outstanding Player, NCAA West Regional Most Outstanding Player, CCAA First-Team, CCAA All-Tournament Team, Daktronics First-Team West Region, NABC First-Team West Region; and
- WHEREAS, Psychology major and student athlete Dahir Nasser was named to the NCAA Elite Eight All-Tournament Team, and CCAA Second-Team; and
- WHEREAS, Communications major and student athlete Donnelle Booker was the game-high scorer in the NCAA Championship game while also earning CCAA Second-Team and NCAA West Region All-Tournament Team; and
- WHEREAS, The Cal Poly Pomona men's basketball team set new school records for victories (28), winning percentage (28-6, .824), fewest losses (6), consecutive victories (15), scoring defense (56.2 ppg – first in the nation), as well as 15 others; and
- WHEREAS, The Bronco men's basketball team elevated school pride and brought the university national prestige with a team of student athletes that conduct themselves at the highest level, on the court and in the classroom; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Cal Poly Pomona Academic Senate formerly recognizes the accomplishments of head coach Greg Kamansky and the Bronco men's basketball team for these extraordinary achievements and this unprecedented triumph.
