Advising at Cal Poly Pomona

Variations in Department Advising Expectations

Advising at Cal Poly Pomona varies by each major and college. You are responsible for contacting **your** major department to determine the advising expectations and how to fulfill them.

- Advising holds are sometimes placed on your record by major
- Frequency of **required** advising may be semester, annually, or not at all
- You may meet with an assigned advisor or meet with any available advisor in your department
- Advisors can be faculty and/or staff
- There may be different advisors for you to see depending on your academic standing (GPA) and career interests

Multiple Advisors, Multiple Holds

You may have multiple academic advisors depending on your college, major, and program participation (EOP, SEES, Honors, Athletics, etc). You may have additional advising holds depending on what programs you are involved with. Check with the program or department to learn of any additional requirements.

Priority Registration

If you are eligible for priority registration, ALL holds must be cleared before you can register.
