

## Methodology

- Use of Desired Results Parent Survey
  - Survey completed in October 2014
  - 62 families out of 78 Responded
- Survey completed after Family Literacy Night
  - 43 out of 45 families participating completed

- Keep a job 68%

## Parent Satisfaction

- 100% of families who responded indicated that they believed their children were both safe & happy in our program
- 90% of families who responded were very satisfied with the quality of our program, and 10% were satisfied
- Family Literacy Night Surveys indicated that Parents believed their children enjoy the classroom activities best
