Plan to [take 30 semester units](#) in your first year and every subsequent year

Review your [transfer credit](#) (Advanced Placement test credit, community college coursework, etc.) with your advisor and submit any necessary petitions

Strive to get a 2.0 GPA or higher

For freshmen: Plan to complete your [GE math and English requirements](#) in your first year

For transfer students: Plan to complete your [GE Upper-Division Synthesis courses](#) in your first year

Know how to read your [major's roadmap](#) and use [CPP Connect Planner](#) to map out your plan
