

## **First Year Checklist**

Meet with <u>your advisor</u> regularly to develop an academic plan and explore academic resources

Plan to take 30 semester units in your first year and every subsequent year

Review your <u>transfer credit</u> (Advanced Placement test credit, community college coursework, etc.) with your advisor and submit any necessary petitions

Strive to get a 2.0 GPA or higher

For freshmen: Plan to complete your GE math and English requirements in your first year

For transfer students: Plan to complete your GE Upper-Division Synthesis courses in your first year

Know how to read your major's roadmap and use CPP Connect Planner to map out your plan

Find a faculty member, staff member, peer mentor or coach on campus that you can go to for questions and concerns

Know how the Learning Resource Center can help you

Bookmark the Student Success Central website

Check your email regularly and read BroncoBytes

Know how <u>Student Health & Wellness Services</u>, <u>Counseling & Psychological Services</u> and <u>Broncos Care Center</u> can help you

Know the breakdown of <u>student fees</u> and learn how to read your <u>financial aid package</u> and <u>account balance</u>
