HyFlex	All course contact hours prescribed by the course classification and units are delivered in-person, synchronously, and asynchronously. Instruction is provided in the classroom, and for each class meeting, students may choose to attend in-person, synchronously online, or asynchronously online. Faculty may require students to attend up to 25% of class meetings in-person, plus the final exam held during finals week. The dates of the required in-person meetings must be included in the schedule of classes before students register for the class. Dates may only be changed with documented consent of all students enrolled in the class.
<p><b>Note</b></p> <p><b>Asynchronous instruction</b> is defined as online instruction that allows students to view instructional materials at any time.</p> <p><b>Synchronous instruction</b> is defined as online or remote broadcast instruction delivered during scheduled class meetings.</p> <p>*As of May 18, 2022, this modality is suspended until further notice. This suspension will lift when the Chancellor’s Office reporting system is able to support this modality.</p>
