

First Year Checklist

Meet with your advisor regularly to develop an academic plan and explore academic
resources
Plan to take 30-semester units in your first year and every subsequent year
Strive to get a 2.0 GPA or higher (CPP, Overall, and Major)
For freshmen: Plan to complete your GE math and English requirements in your first year For transfer students: Plan to complete your lower-division prerequisites in your first-year
Review your transfer credit (Advanced Placement test credit, community college coursework, etc.) with your advisor and submit any necessary petitions
Know how to read your curriculum sheet and roadmap
Find a faculty member, staff member, peer mentor, or coach on campus that you can go to for questions and concerns
Know how the Learning Resource Center can help you
Check your CPP email regularly
Know how Student Health & Wellness Services, Counseling & Psychological Services, and Bronco Care Center can help you
Know the breakdown of student fees and learn how to read your financial aid package and account balance
Confirm your major is the best fit for you. If you are considering a different major , visit an advisor as soon as possible. Explore career resources at the Career Center
Explore clubs , internships , and other extracurricular opportunities in your major or majors you're interested
