The event, presented by the Cal Poly Pomona Philharmonic Orchestra, will feature pre-concert activities for the whole family starting at 11:30am including "Danny's Farm" petting zoo. The concert begins at 1:00pm and will feature *Carnival of the Animals* by Camille Saint-Saëns and *Peter and the Wolf* by Sergei Prokofiev.

When asked about the significance of this event, Dr. Janine Riveire, who directs the Philharmonic Orchestra, explains "The Festival of Animals is an event we are presenting for the whole Pomona community. Families are invited to celebrate the wonderful way that music tells us about our world: it can tell stories and make us laugh or cry, and it brings us together. *Carnival of the Animals* and *Peter and the Wolf* were written especially for children.
