

# Senior Design Project Application & Enrollment Guidelines

The following *prerequisites* are required:

- **All students** must pass the Graduate Writing Test (GWT) (currently waived due to COVID)
- **All students** must have a GPA of 2.0 or Higher.
- **All students** must finish ECE 3301/L (Introduction to Microcontrollers/ Introduction to Microcontrollers Lab) courses with a passing grade before starting their SDP.
- **CpE students** must finish ECE 3300/L (Digital Circuit Design Using Verilog/ Digital Circuit Design Using Verilog Lab) courses with a passing grade before starting their SDP.
- **EE students** must finish ECE 3200 (Microelectronic Devices and Circuits) course with a passing grade before starting their SDP.

**All students** must finish all the required prerequisites before starting the SDP. Otherwise, the applications will be *accepted conditionally* upon completing a certain prerequisite or *rejected* if the prerequisites are not satisfied. **No** prerequisites *waivers* will be granted, so please make sure to *plan* your course of study to finish the prerequisites *before* starting the SDP.

- Students can apply for starting the SDP in Fall or Spring. The **due date** for *applying* to the SDP using the SDP application in the link provided by the department email each semester is the **end of week 8 of the application semester**.
1. The **due dates** for *receiving and submitting SDP contract* after the application is accepted
    - Case prerequisites are *satisfied*,
      - Students will *receive* the contract by **end of week 11 of the application semester**
      - Students must sign the contract by an **ECE advisor**, and the **due dates to return the contracts** is **end of week 14 of the application semester**.
      - Instructions on how to return the contract will be clarified in the email that include the contract.
    - Case prerequisites are *not satisfied*,
      - Students will wait until the prerequisite courses' grades are issued and then upload their **Updated Transcripts** highlighting the grades of the prerequisite courses **no later than one week after the grades due date of the application semester**.
      - Students will *receive* the contract after their applications are reviewed to sign it by an **ECE advisor**
      - Students will have to *return the contracts* **no later than one week before the next semester of the application semester**.
      - Instructions on how to return the contract will be clarified in the email that include the contract.
  2. Once the SDP contract is signed by an **ECE advisor**, students must finish the following:

- **All students** shall register for both **EGR 4810** (seminar class) offered by an ECE instructor and **EGR 4820** (student advisor class) with an **ECE instructor** in the first semester of their SDP.
- **All students** shall register for **EGR 4830** (student advisor class) with the same **ECE instructor** for EGR 4820 in the second semester of their SDP.
