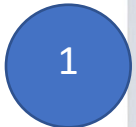




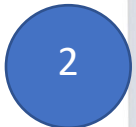

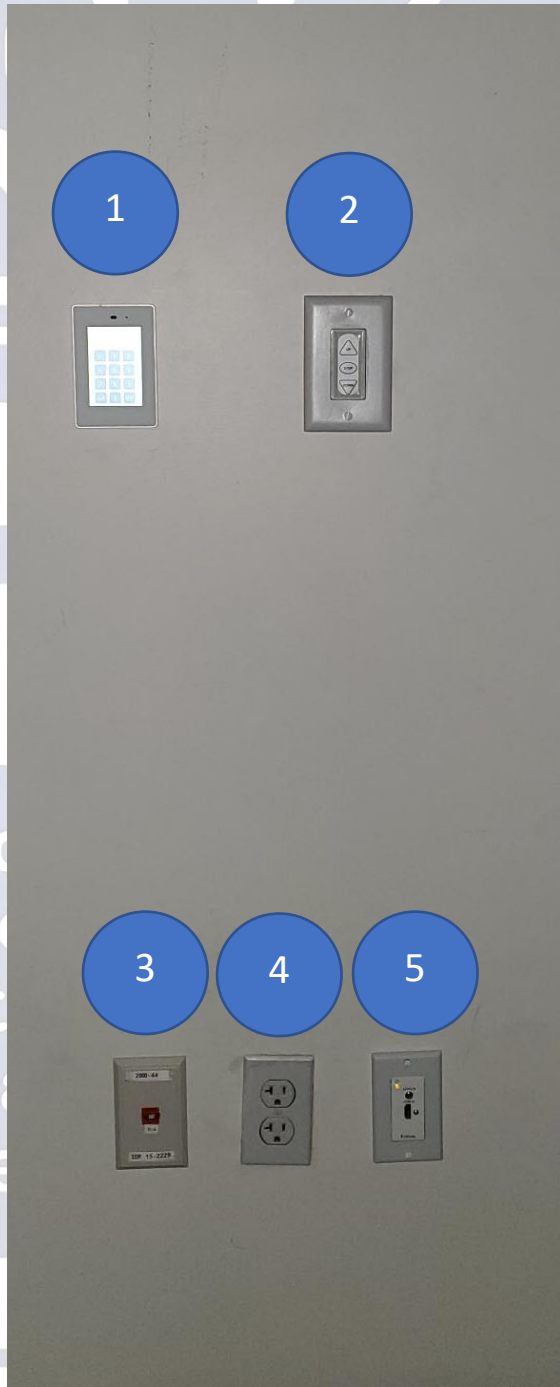

### System Start-up

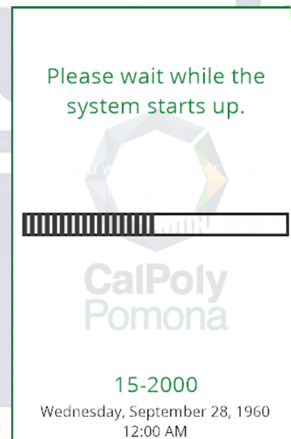
HDMI connection allows users to bring their own device to use the system. An HDMI cable can be checked out at the counter.

1. Plug your device into the wall plate connection using an HDMI cable.

### Control Panel

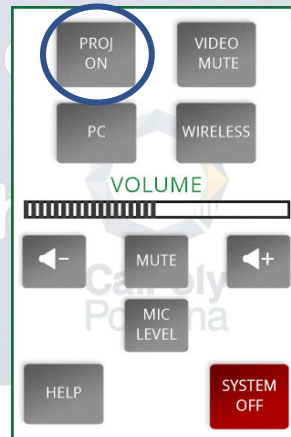
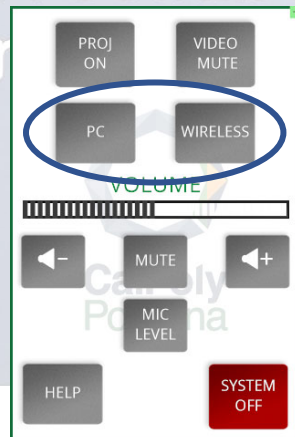
The control panel is the primary way of controlling the system from startup to shutdown.

2. Unlock the system to automatically start the projector and lower the screen with the passcode given during registration.



### Main Control Panel Page

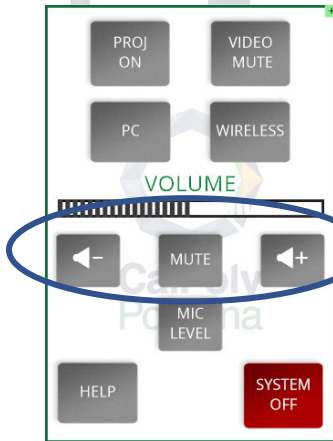
3. Select desired input source to be displayed: PC or Wireless
4. If desired select VIDEO MUTE to temporarily blank the display while preparing content, press once more to view image.





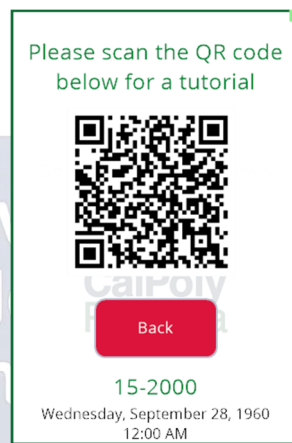
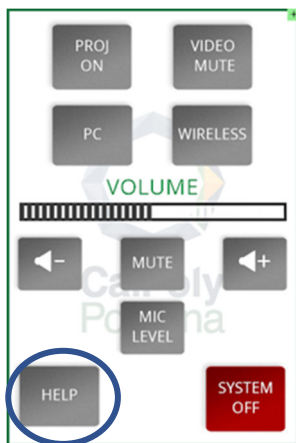
Main Control Panel Page Cont.

Press HELP, call x4040 for immediate assistance or select the TUTORIAL button for the QR Code. Press BACK to return to the main page.

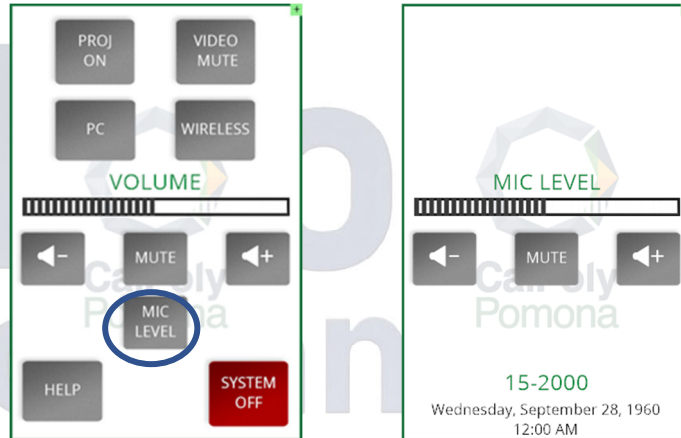




## University Library

To adjust the volume on the wireless microphone, MIC LEVEL and make volume adjustments on the pop-up page



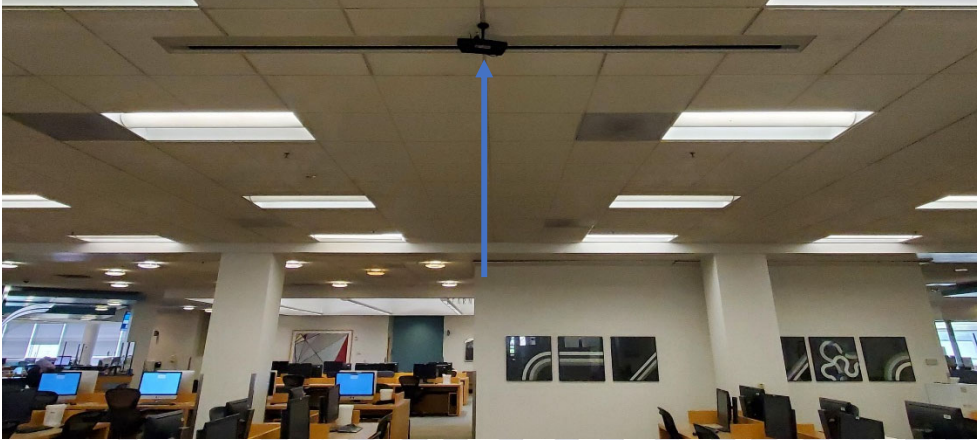

Infrared over the ear and neck loop receivers can be checked out at the counter for usage



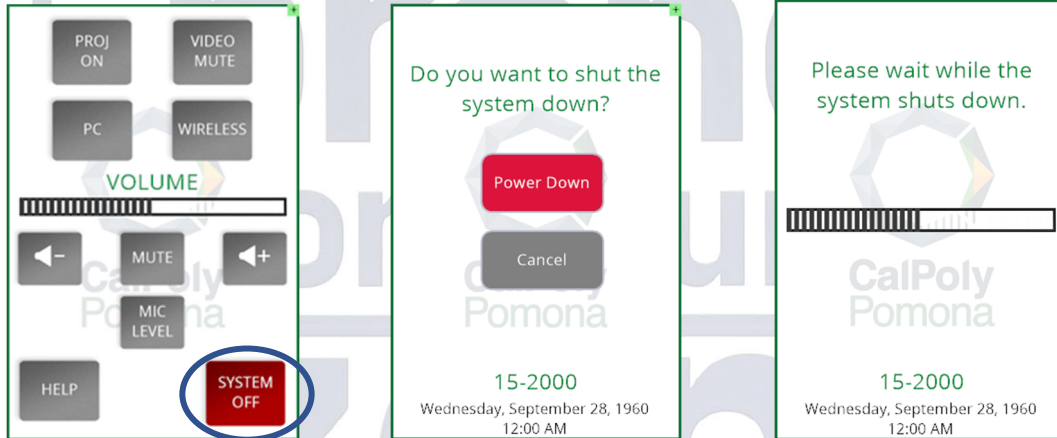
