BACKGROUND: The Department of Education has put forward a referral for M.A. in Education – Teaching & Learning Online Option for semesters. This is a new program, offered because online education is widespread, and the growing demand for quality online trainers and educators is only increasing. The Teaching and Learning Online option, the first fully online graduate program at Cal Poly Pomona, prepares students (current and future teachers) to gain ground in the pedagogy of online teaching and learning, becoming effective online educators. While experiencing the fully online environments, students learn how to create teaching materials optimized for virtual classrooms, based on online environments and the needs of the new generation of students in P-12 focusing on learner engagement and authentic learning outcomes.
