- Establish transparent and consistent standards for chair assignments

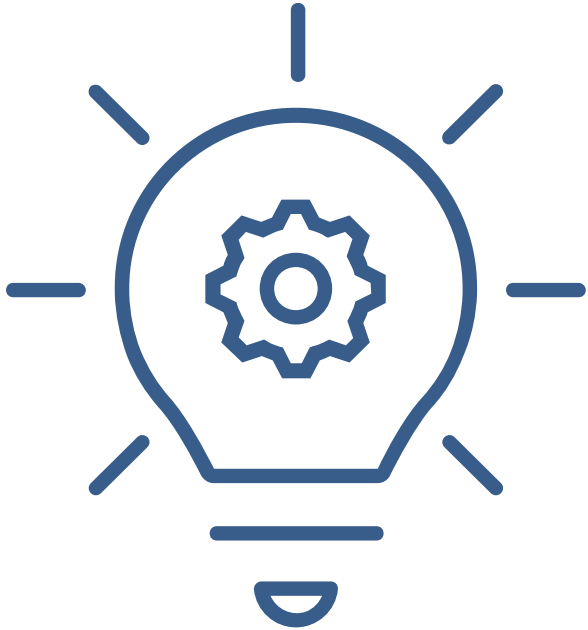
Academic Affairs Priorities

- Augment investment in Provost's Teacher-Scholar Program and develop common rubric to increase access and equity across the colleges

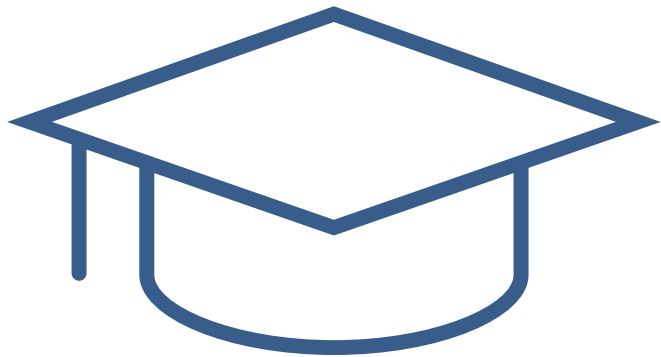
Academic Affairs Priorities
