SUBJECT: Updated Per-Unit Tuition Costs for the Military Student Tuition Assistance Program

While the California State University is not increasing systemwide tuition for the 2018-19 academic year, the attached per-unit tuition schedule for military students has been updated to portray accurate tuition rates and clarify language in the schedule. Campuses must update any information regarding per-unit tuition costs or other fees for military students on their websites, handouts or other documents provided to military students inquiring about – and using – military tuition assistance.

Background

On March 15, 2011, the Department of Defense (DOD) issued Instruction Number 1322.25, incorporating Change 3 (Instruction), effective July 7, 2014. The Instruction sets eligibility criteria for participation in the DOD Tuition Assistance program by educational institutions and requires them to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The required MOU was signed by all CSU presidents in late November 2014. One of the requirements of the MOU is to publish a systemwide per-unit tuition schedule for the purposes of calculating tuition costs for military students. The CSU Office of the Chancellor published the initial schedule on November 24, 2014.

CSU Mil Rate	These amounts are the per unit tuition amount for military students using Military Tuition Assistance.
Mi/TA Student Credit	These amounts (in red) depict the credit provided to military students using Mi/TA tuition rates. CSU tuition cannot exceed rates charged other non-military students.
CSU Tuition Cap	These amounts represent the maximum amount of tuition the CSU can charge any student including those using Mi/TA. These rates are the same for all students attending CSU campuses.
Mi/TA Pays	These amounts are the maximum amounts of financial aid paid by the DOD for students using Mi/TA. These amounts may vary depending on a number of military service factors.
Out-of-Pocket Cost	These amounts represent the out-of-pocket tuition cost for students using Mi/TA. These costs do not reflect campus-based fees.
CSU Rate Overage	These amounts (in green) are tuition costs the CSU absorbs for students using Mi/TA.
