What Can Be Done Under the First Amendment?

Express ideas that are disagreeable or hurtful to society.



Chalk on sidewalks without damaging grounds or buildings.

Have speakers.

Assemble and protest.

Express speech to oppose, denounce, or dissent another form of free speech ("more speech").



Punish speech over the internet and social media that is a true threat and harassment.

Use a bull horn in public places during reasonable times and without disruption of business.

Distribute leaflets in public areas.

Picket with signs that are not true threats.



Punish or censor speech that meets the legal criteria for harassment, true threats, or other speech acts unprotected by the First Amendment.
