The Class Pass is a transit fare card that makes it easy for you to get to campus, go out to eat, head to downtown LA, and lots more — without a car and without paying for a single ride.

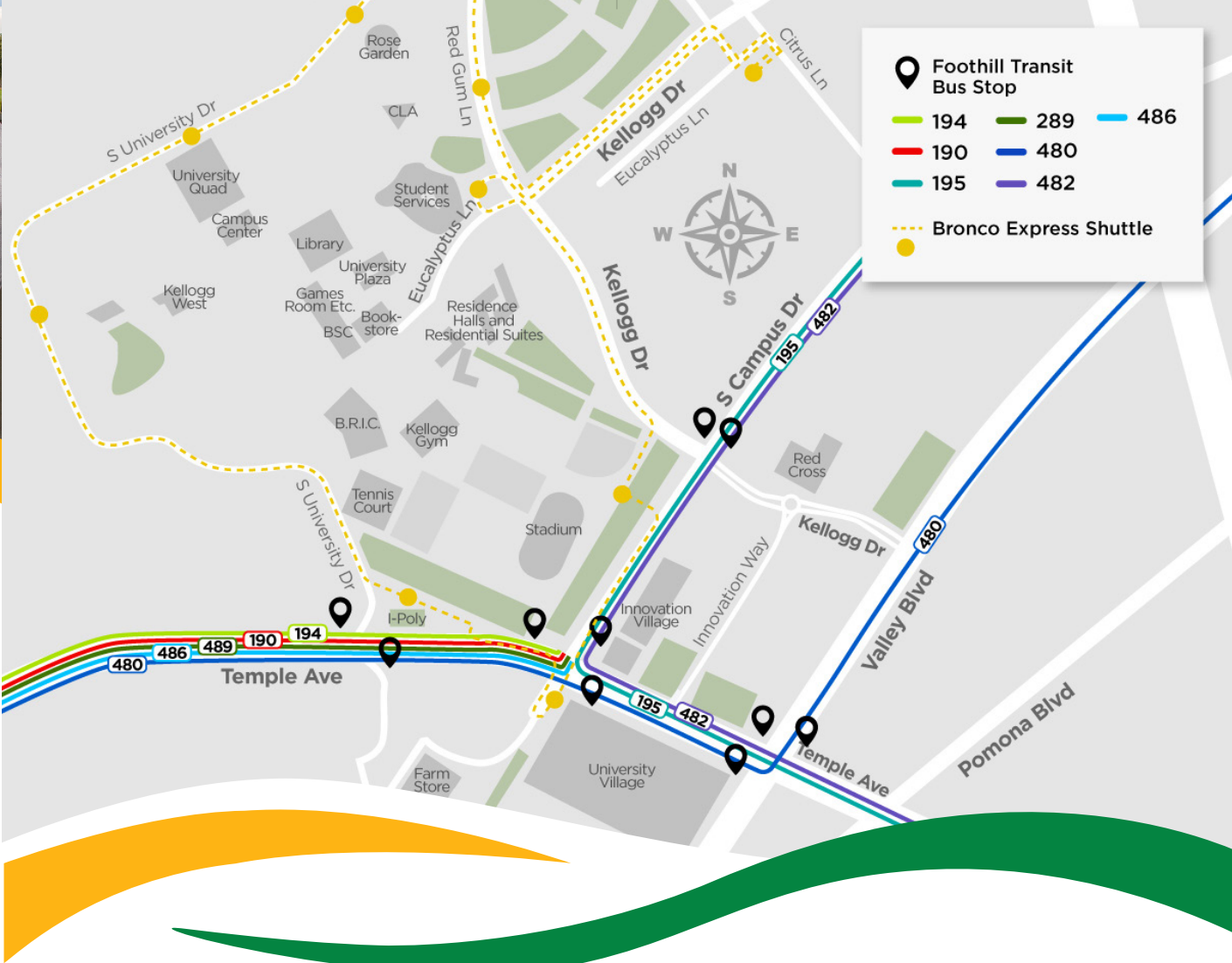

Class Pass Fast Facts

What's a Class Pass?

The Class Pass is a pilot program that gives current students at Cal Poly Pomona **free rides on Foothill Transit local and Silver Streak buses** all year long. It also helps the community by reducing traffic and parking congestion around campus. Not bad for a piece of plastic.

Who is eligible for the Class Pass?

All currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students with at least 1 credit unit at Cal Poly Pomona are eligible to get a Class Pass. Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Online Learning and Certificate enrolled students are not eligible.

Where Can I Use It?

The Class Pass is accepted on all Foothill Transit **Local and Silver Streak buses**, which connect to 22 different cities throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys, plus downtown Los Angeles.

Which Lines Serve Cal Poly Pomona?

Foothill Transit Lines **190, 194, 195, 289, 480, 482, and 486** travel throughout campus, with stops along Campus Dr. and Temple Ave.

How Do I Get a Class Pass?

Bring your school ID to the **Bronco Student Center, Games Room, Etc. (Bldg. 35-1110)** to pick one up. You may need to make a reservation online. Visit cpp.edu/transportation/classpass.shtml for more information.

How Does the Class Pass Work?

When you board the bus, simply **touch your Class Pass** on the TAP symbol right on the farebox until you hear a beep - that means your fare was accepted, and you, my friend, are riding for free!

When Can I Use My Class Pass?

The Class Pass pilot program has you covered for the whole school year as long as you're enrolled in classes!

What if I Lose My Pass?

Just visit the **Bronco Student Center, Games Room, Etc. (Bldg. 35-1110)** to report your lost pass and pay a \$10 replacement fee. You'll get a **new Class Pass** on the spot!

Where Can I Go with My Class Pass?

Anywhere Foothill Transit goes, you can go too! Buses travel throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys, and downtown Los Angeles. Catch a **Silver Streak** bus at the El Monte Station or Pomona Transit Center for an easy ride to see events at the **STAPLES Center** or a night out at **LA Live**.
